

## Cypress Landing Women's Golf Association (CLWGA) Hole-in-One Participation

## Informational Fact Sheet

The cost to participate in the Hole-in-One pool is \$5.00.

The CLWGA Handbook states that to be eligible for the Hole-in-One payout:

- The player must have paid the \$5.00 entry fee prior to the hole-in-one round.
- The player must be a CLWGA member.
- The player must have achieved the hole-in-one at Cypress Landing Golf Course.
- Another player must witness the hole-in-one.
- The hole-in-one does not need to occur on a CLWGA play day.
- Any round is eligible all during the year from closing day to closing day.

A hole-in-one occurs when the ball is hit from the teeing area into the cup on the green and stays there. There must be a witness to testify to your feat. The hole-in-one must be part of a formal round of golf (nine or, **not necessarily during a WGA-sponsored event**, and not a practice round where only a few holes are played. "The USGA recommends that a hole-in-one be considered if made during a round of at least 9 holes, except that a hole-in-one made during a match should be acceptable even if the match end before the stipulated round is completed.
